Looking back over my nearly six years as a Board and Program Committee member, I'm struck by the growth Sky's the Limit Fund has experienced: not just in funding raised, but in the number of program partners and the scope of our assistance to families. We've gone from partnering with our original one program in 2010 to fourteen of the most respected and trusted programs in the field, located throughout the United States and offering a range of diverse approaches to wilderness therapy. In 2022, STLF added Blue Ridge and Trails Carolina as well as Summit Traverse, our first transition program partner. This year we have also increased the amount of our Local Continuum of Care reimbursement to families, making our aftercare support more robust. As a wilderness parent myself, every visit I make to STLF's program partners impresses me with their commitment to helping our youth heal, and reminds me how grateful I am for the transformative experience of my own child in wilderness therapy.

A PATHWAY TO HOPE THAT HEALS



Our mission is to provide extensive support and financial assistance for wilderness therapy to adolescents and young adults in crisis and their families in need.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Believing that cost should not be a barrier to anyone seeking wilderness therapy treatment for their child, Sky's the Limit Fund (STLF) provides financial assistance to offset the high cost and enable youth and young adults in crisis to attend one of our Program Partners. Our Partners also provide a reduction in tuition, further reducing the financial burden for the family.



AFTERCARE ALLIANCE

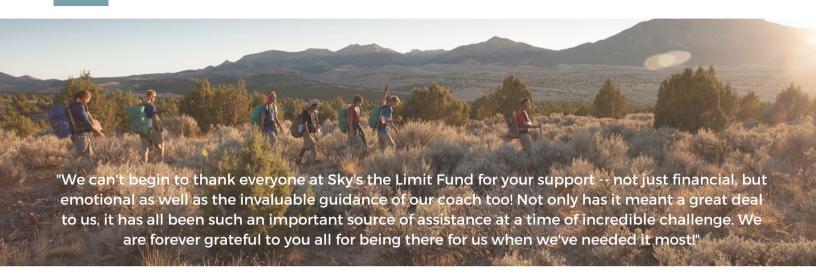
Every young adult and family that receives financial support from Sky's the Limit Fund may apply to receive support through our Coaching Service. STLF coaches provide approximately 12 hours of coaching over the course several months to clinically approved families/young adults to help ease the transition home. Through weekly phone calls, the STLF coach supports and guides the family/young adult, expanding on the gains made in wilderness therapy.

CORNERSTONE COMMUNITY

You Are Not Alone.

We walk with you until it's your idea to walk on your own by providing people with a shared experience; willing, available, and understanding. We make experienced staff, parent support, and resources available to families to give them the emotional and practical support to successfully navigate the treatment process. STLF hosts events to educate and bring awareness to the community on the benefits of wilderness therapy and transitional support.

VITAL IMPACT & GROWTH



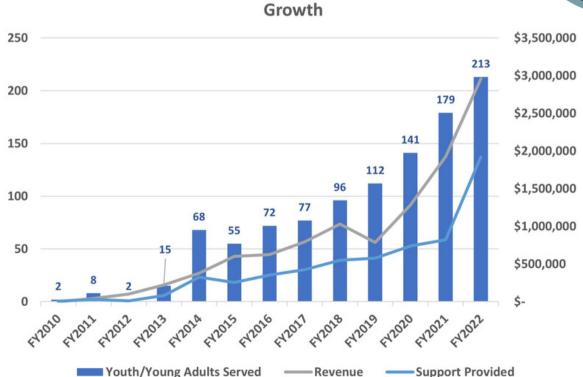
In fiscal year 2022 (July 1, 2021 - June 30, 2022) STLF provided \$1.9M of support to 213 youth/young adults and their families as follows: Financial Assistance for wilderness therapy: \$1,789,261

Coaching Services: \$101,794

Local Continuum of Care: \$30,297

Since inception in 2010, we have provided over \$6.6M of support to over 1113 youth/young adults and their families. The total support to families including our wilderness program partner's reduction in fees is over \$12M.

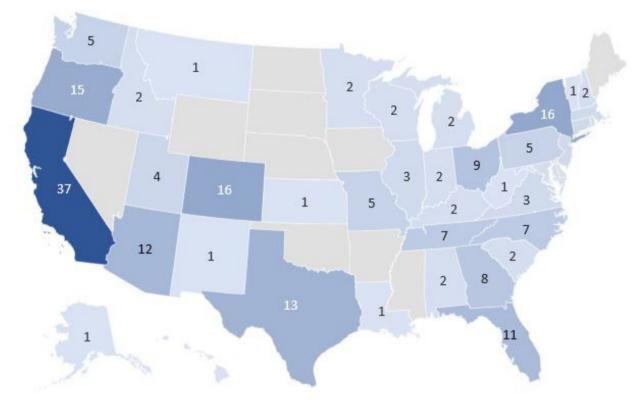
FAMILIES WE SERVE

54 parent(s)/guardian(s) and 10 young adults participated in our Coaching Service which provides transitional support for the entire family. We served 213 youth/young adults and their families from 38 states* in fiscal year 2022.
Participants are diverse and include, but are not limited to, Asian, Black/African American, Hispanic/Latino, American Indian/Alaskan Native and White.



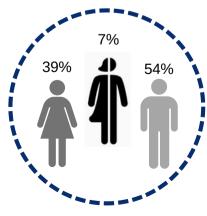


AGES

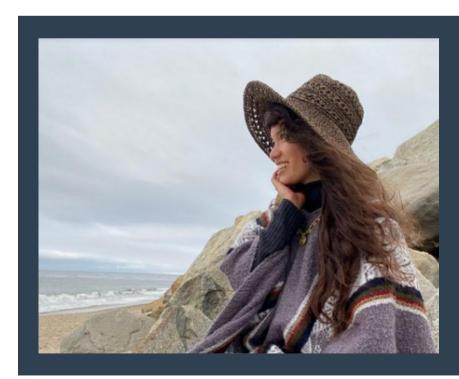
Thank you to those who have provided testimonials supporting wilderness therapy, the STLF coaching service, our program partnership and the services we provide to those in need.

Sky's the Limit Fund partners with 14 wilderness therapy programs across the United States from Hawaii to Maine. In fiscal year 2022 we added Blue Ridge Therapeutic Wilderness and Trails Carolina to our program partners.

STLF's goal is to continue to partner with programs that are accredited and that offer unique treatment options and/or focus on a specific mental health issue. We have a very thorough vetting and interview process to ensure the programs meet our standards. These standards include: maintaining a high level of accountability, transparency and safety, having a family component, and measuring outcomes.

We are inspired by the important work our partners do with the youth and families. We are grateful that they provide a reduction in tuition, further reducing the financial burden on the families.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The collective impact of the community is vital to end the stigma of mental health illness, to raise awareness of the benefits of wilderness therapy, and to stress the importance of treatment accessibility. STLF's goal is to build reciprocal and sustainable relationships to guide our organization through these positive outcomes.

With travel restrictions and social distancing easing, our community engagement expanded from virtual meetings to in-person connections. STLF hosted our Nightlights! Gala, co-hosted events in Houston and Chicago, visited four program partners, and attended the NATSAP and OBH conferences.
